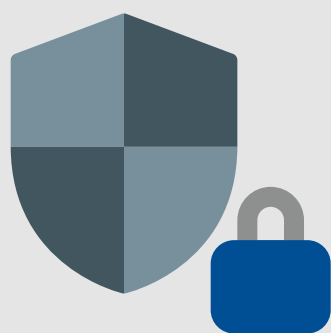

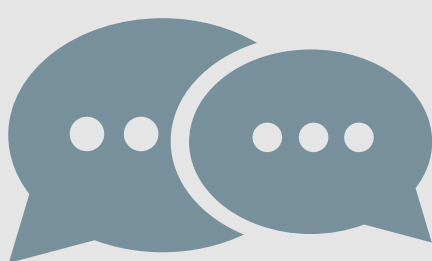
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Six Tips For Parents



1 SECURE PRIVACY SETTINGS

Make sure all privacy settings are set to the strictest level for online gaming and electronic devices.



2 DISCUSS INTERNET SAFETY

Your kids need you to protect them. Keeping an open line of communication and monitoring their use of the internet will keep them safe.



3 REVIEW AND APPROVE

Making sure you review and approve your children's games, apps, and approving their profiles and what they post online



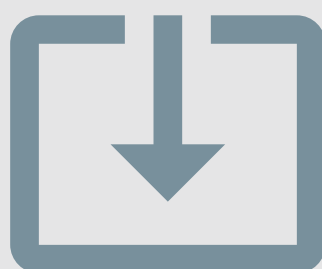
4 OUT IN THE OPEN

Keep electronic devices in an open, common room in the house. You wouldn't let them take actual strangers in their room!



5 LIMIT WHAT YOU CAN TO KEEP IDENTITY SAFE

limiting voice chat capabilities in games, and masking real name or any contact information in what may be publicly displayed to keep your child's identity safe from strangers.



6 NO DOWNLOADING WITHOUT APPROVAL

Making sure your children aren't downloading any apps or software without your approval first is important. Understand what the app does and review its privacy policy to protect your child's privacy.
